	Pilgrim Fathers	were a group of religion refugees, who sailed to the New World, 	from Plymouth in 1620. 
	The Mayflower was the ship	which the Pilgrim fathers sailed on 	to the new continent in 1620. 
	Boston Tea Party	was one of the protests against the British rule 	in 1713. 
	George Washington	was not only the leader of the American Army 	but also the first American president from 1789 to 1797. 
	The first thirteen colonies	gained the independence 	with the Treaty of Paris in 1783. 
	Declaration of Independence	was written by Thomas Jefferson 	and declared on 4 July 1776. 



 The first capitol of the USA	was in Philadelphia 	from 1790 to 1800. 
 Gold Rush	started with the discovery of gold 	in California in 1848. 
 Era of expansion was	a period of colonization of the West 	from the half of the 19th century. 
 Abraham Lincoln	was elected president 	in 1861. 
 General Lee, leader of the Confederation Army	stood against General Grant, leader of the Unionists 	in the Civil War. 
 The Civil War	was a military conflict between the South and the North 	from 1861 to 1865. 
 Emancipation Proclamation	abolished the black / negro slavery 	in 1863.
