Background information:

- *Basic information*
- *Geography, nature, climate*

- *Basic information: area: 268,675 km²*
 - population: 3,500,000 (87% British, 12% Maori)*
 - capital: Wellington*
 - languages: English, Maori*
 - flag, currency, driving left*
 - member of the Commonwealth of Nations*
- *Geography: 2 large islands, North and South Island*
 - mainly hilly, several lowland areas, Mt Cook – the highest*
 - rivers short, lakes*
 - climate – moderate, oceanic*
- *Political system: dominion, parliamentary democracy*
 - Head of State – British monarch, Governor General*
 - central government + over 900 local authorities*
 - Parliament → monarch*
 - House of Representatives – elected*
 - Legislative Council (abolished in 1950)*
 - Prime Minister + cabinet*
- *History: first inhabitants – Maori (Polynesian origin)*
 - 1642 discoverer Abel Tasman, 1769 James Cook*
 - 1852 self-government*
 - 1907 a dominion, 1931 full independence*

- *Economy: highly developed country, leading farming country (sheep – more than people, cattle)*
- *People: Sir Edmund Hillary (first to Mt. Everest)*
 - Lord of the Rings, Hobbit*
 - Rugby (All Blacks), cricket*

Task:**Teacher's notes:**

Forbidden words.

Print the handout and cut it into the cards.

The game can be played in pairs or in groups of three.

Give a pile of cards to a pair of students. One student picks up a card and tries to explain the word given to the other student, who does not see the card. They mustn't use the other three words which are on the card. The quickest pair may be the winners of the race in the class.

Or when they play it in three, one student explains, the other two guess, who is quicker gets the card, the student with most cards is the winner.

Follow-up activity:

Discuss all information, use video (YouTube or other sources) to show e.g. haka dance, landscape, extracts from the famous movies etc.
