Teacher's notes:

Task I. Merory Game. Did they meet?

The principle of the game is pelmanism (pexeso) and is for group s of three or four.

- 1) Copy and cut the cards with British personalities. Give each group a set of cards.
- 2) Students put the cards on the desk with the names hidden. The aim is to find a pair of personalities who met during their lives and have something to do with each other. One student turns over one card, looks for a matching card, if they don't find it, they turn both cards back and the other student continues. The winner is the student with most cards and in the class the quickest group.

Task II. Who did what and when?
