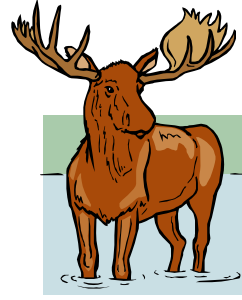

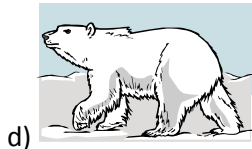

### **Background information:**

- *Basic information :* area 10,000,000 km<sup>2</sup>  
capital Ottawa  
population 32 million  
languages English (59%), French (23%)  
Native Americans, Inuit (2%)  
symbols – flag, currency (Can.dollar)
- *Geography, nature, climate*
- *Political system*
- *History*
- *National economy*
- *Culture, people, sport*
- **Geography:**
  - large mountainous areas – the Cordilleras (the Rocky Mts., the Mackenzie Mts), highest peak – Mt.Logan (5950m)
  - a lot of lakes (great Lakes Region, Great Bear, Great Slave)
  - a lot of rivers – Mackenzie, Yukon, St.Lawrence
  - climate – moderate, subarctic, arctic
  - people: 89% of the land has no permanent population  
59% - British origin, 23% French, 2% Native, 16% others
- **Political system:**  
constitutional monarchy, dominion, independent, federal state  
parliamentary democracy  
10 provinces + 3 territories (Inuit territory Nunavut in 1999)  
Parliament – monarch, Senate, House of Commons  
Prime Minister + Cabinet  
Queen – head of state, Governor General
- **History:**  
similar to history of the USA, colonization by the British and French  
1867 – dominion, 1931 – constitutional autonomy
- **National economy:**  
Among the world's biggest and soundest, G-7 countries  
Raw materials – oil, metal, coal, gas, timber,...  
Agriculture – one of the leading countries
- **Culture, Sports**
