#### Teacher's notes:

Forbidden words.

Print the handout and cut it into the cards.

The game can be played in pairs or in groups of three.

Give a pile of cards to a pair of students. One student picks up a card and tries to explain the word given to the other student, who does not see the card. They mustn't use the other three words which are on the card. The quickest pair may be the winners of the race in the class. Or when they play it in three, one student explains, the other two guess, who is quicker gets the card, the student with most cards is the winner.
